




**Fun Run – 10:15 am**

**10k Race – 11:00 am**

Thank you for entering the SMaRTT Smasher off-road chip-timed 10k race which takes place on **Sunday 9th February 2020**. **The Race is Race #5 of the Wiltshire Off-Road Race League** and is likely to be popular, so you are advised to enter early. **The Fun Run is in the Wiltshire Junior League.**

1. Registration takes place at Calne Town Hall, The Strand, Calne, Wiltshire, SN11 0EN, registration will be open from 9am – car parking is available at Carnegie Mews which is opposite the town hall and parking here is free on Sundays, parking is also at the car park adjacent to the Co-Operative store in the town centre and surrounding streets.
2. Fun run entrants will need to be at the start line for 10am for the race briefing – 10k entrants to be at the start line for 10:45 for a race briefing for an 11:00 am prompt start.
3. Toilets are available at the registration area which is a short walk from the start line, at registration you will be given your race number which is to be worn on the front.

4. This year once again **LPSEVENTS**  are assisting with the timing of the event and we will be offering chip timing enabling us to provide you with accurate race results. You will be given your chip at registration and it is important that you give back your chip at the end of the race, there is a £15 charge for any chips that are not returned.
5. The course route will be explained during the race briefing however it is an out and back route and well-marshalled, so it is easy to follow, water is available on the course. The weather conditions in February are changeable and, in the past, we have had both sunshine and rain on race day so please dress appropriately for the conditions – the course is on the cycle track so may well be muddy!! You can follow the S'MaRTT Smasher race on Facebook for regular weather and course condition updates. Part of the course is on tarmac pathways so will be unsuitable for spikes.
6. The course is narrow in places although there will always be enough room throughout the route for two runners to be alongside each other, as this is an out and back route you will at some point have runners coming towards you so please keep to the left-hand side of the path and follow the marshal's directions as they are there to ensure your safety.
7. Once finished you will be directed back to the town hall where you can collect your race memento. A selection of hot and cold drinks will be available to purchase and the raffle draw will also be taking place. You will also find here a fantastic selection of cakes.
8. CK Clinic (<http://www.ckclinic.co.uk>) will be there offering complimentary post-race massage on the day.

9. Prizes – fun runners will be given their medals as they cross the finish line. The 10k entrants' prizes will be awarded in the town hall following the race and are awarded in the following categories:

1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> male and female open

1<sup>st</sup> vet male - 40/50/60

1<sup>st</sup> vet female - 35/45/55

1<sup>st</sup> team – male/female (first 3 team members to count).

**Prize Giving will be at 12:15.**
